2022 SHELTER NUMBERS

- 4% more animals entered shelter than left from previous year.
- This is up from 2% in 2021
- This is the largest gap in the past four years
- The number of animals entering shelter continues to slightly increase each year since the pandemic.
- It is still 16% less than 2019
- Dog intakes represented the majority of the increase
- Dog adopton rates remained very consistent throughout 2022, with 53% of dogs being adopted by year end

NATIONAL TRENDS

Lenth of stay in shelters/rescues has significally increased

• The euthanasia rate for dogs was 8.2%, an increase from 5.9% in 2021







COMBINATION OF FACTORS

Costs of pet ownership and services/medical/food/supplies all increased 9% (average) over last year. Study by Forbes said that 42% of pet owners said a vet bill of \$999 or more would cause them to go into dept.

Lack of staff and resources also impacted the well-being of animals. Lack of people-related resources (fosters, volunteers, staff, etc.) negatively impacted the outcome of animals





